logical fallacies handlistarguments to avoid when writing - logical fallacies 1 logical fallacies handlist: arguments to avoid when writing fallacies are statements that might sound reasonable or true but are actually flawed or dishonest. when readers detect them, these logical fallacies backfire by making the audience think the writer is (a) unintelligent or (b) deceptive.
