lubrication guide v 2.0 - ue systems - bearing can still be tested and a lubrication action level set. if the fitting is of a non-sound conductive material such as plastic, a separate conductive metallic wave guide can be installed so that the bearing can be monitored. the wave guide can be isolated from structure borne noise of the machine (the mounting point) via rubber isolation ...
